Garden Island housed WA's first European settlement under the governance of Captain James Stirling. By 7 June 1829 Stirling had established his headquarters on the island at Cliff Head, a place we will explore with insights from Dr Pamela Statham and Dr Shane Burke.

We will also learn about the island's rich environmental history and why it became a major naval facility, now known as HMAS Stirling. After lunch at The Anchorage we will be able to visit the Navy's Museum before we return.
